Subject: Instructions for amending the requirements of granting Type Approvals for Telecommunications equipment and terminal devices Resolution No. (7-10/2019) dated (05/09/2019)

In response to TRC's Instructions for amending the requirements of granting Type Approvals for Telecommunications equipment and terminal devices, we Zebra Technologies Corporation, hereby submit our comments as follows:

We understand that TRC have amended their regulations for PTT/PoC devices, whereby it is required to obtain special import permission from the relevant Authorities in Jordan. Zebra appreciates any concern TRC has with these product types, however obtaining import permission on case-by-case basis poses potential business risk to Zebra and other manufacturers of these product types.

We would request that TRC issue regulations to address the PTT/PoC services, so that in future, manufacturers can obtain formal Type Approval certificates from TRC confirming compliance to the Jordan requirements. This would allow TRC to implement, if deemed necessary, a 'streamlined' import process.
